

Minutes May 26, 2015

The City of Langdon Place held its regular monthly meeting at the John Knox Presbyterian Church. Mayor Frank called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Present at the meeting: Mayor Mike Frank, Commissioners Scott Jones, Kathleen Snyder, Charlie O'Bryan, Chris Beach, Attorney Stan Chauvin III and City clerk/Treasurer Theresa O'Bryan. Guest attending were Lauren Roberts and Scott Scinta.

Absent from the meeting: None

The minutes from the April meeting were read. Councilmember Scott made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Council Member Snyder seconded it. It passed in favor of accepting the minutes 5/0.

Old Business: Scott Scinta expressed his love for the trees in the neighborhood. He said the neighborhood looks great. Suggested that Bob Ray Company could be a future vender for the neighborhood for tree service. He had work done in the past with the company.

Glen Stuckel put up two way flashing lights at the intersection of Blossom and Goose Creek Road.

New Business: Lauren Roberts informed the city of the ADT security system and passed out pamphlets.

Councilmember Beach informed the city he will be moving out of the city by the end of June. He will need to resign at that point and had suggested that his neighbor Janice Alvy would be interested in filling his seat.

The council gave permission for City Clerk O'Bryan to spend \$200 for an array of flowers for previous Mayor Weitlauf in the event of her untimely death. O'Bryan will keep the Council informed of Weitlauf's health.
