

Minutes November 26, 2019

The City of Langdon place held its regular monthly meeting at the John Knox Presbyterian Church.

Mayor Mike Frank called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Present at the meeting: Mayor Mike Frank, Commissioners Aaron Hardy, Kenny Bauer, Charlie O'Bryan, Scott Scinta, Attorney Stan Chauvin III and City Clerk/Treasurer Theresa O'Bryan.

The minutes from the October meeting were read. Council member Aaron Hardy made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Council member Kenny Bauer seconded the motion. It passed in favor of accepting the minutes 5/0.

Old Business: Resident Moose asked the council to look into a better approach to the current up lighting at the Westport Road entrance walls. He was also concerned the memorial plaque landscaping needed sprucing up. Moose was satisfied with the leaf removal and the elimination of the 4 speed humps at the four way stop at Blossom Lane and Kennersley Drive.

Council member Hardy reminded everyone of the leaf removal dates starting Monday the following week. He was going to forward a city map with all the streets on it, to the company for reference. Hardy said he is waiting on John Waters to begin working on the Westport Road entrance lighting issue.

Attorney Chauvin reported that he is working on the annex issue.

New Business: Council member Bauer would like to see a better presence of security later in the evening hours instead of the midday hours. It was suggest that Bauer take over the scheduling of the security with LMPD.

Council member Scinta checked of the cost and functions of the blinking LED stop signs. The cost per sign with the Taoco Company runs \$1600.00 per sign. It was suggested that Scinta see if there is any other companies that are less expensive.

Finance Report: The monthly bill report was presented to the council for review. Council member Scinta made a motion to approve the bills and council member Bauer seconded it. It passed 5/0 in favor.
