

Minutes May 26, 2020

The City of Langdon place held its regular monthly meeting at the John Knox Presbyterian Church.

Mayor Mike Frank called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Present at the meeting: Mayor Mike Frank, Commissioners Kenny Bauer, Charlie O'Bryan, Scott Scinta, Aaron Hardy, Attorney Stan Chauvin III and City Clerk/Treasurer Theresa O'Bryan.

Absent from the meeting: None

Guests attending the meeting: None

The minutes from the February meeting were read. Council member Scott Scinta made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Council member Kenny Bauer seconded the motion. It passed in favor of accepting the minutes 5/0.

Mayor Mike Frank began the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Frank informed the Council that Bob Ray will be treating 139 trees for Emerald ash borer and Integrity Landscaping will be replacing 6 trees that have died.

The Kentucky Department for Local Government has allocated up to \$70,162 for a Coronavirus relief fund, available to City of Langdon Place. Mayor Mike will look into ways the fund can be accessed.

Commissioner Aaron Hardy presented the Council with the specs for the refurbishing of the Goose Creek Road entrance walls. The plan is to have the walls painted, signage to match the Westport walls and refurbish the electrical as well as installing new light fixtures. Council member Kenny Bauer made a motion to move forward on the project and to have Weber Group to start manufacturing the new signage. Council member Scott Scinta seconded it and it passed 5/0 in favor of acceptance.

Council member Scott Scinta reported the web-site is updated. The ditches have been cleared by David Tapp. Scott also stated he will begin to work on the welcome packet soon.

Council member Charlie O'Bryan will be walking sidewalks and checking on the city curbs in need of repair. He will report back next month on this project.

Council member Bauer reported that MSD has been working on the ditch lines behind Blossom. It will flow better once cleaned out.

Attorney Chauvin informed the Council that Officer Mudd is offering Cities a bicycle police patrol for \$45/hour. He also reported that he still needs to talk with Candi Atkinson to resolve the annexation issue at hand.

Issues reported to the Council:

1. Resident still has issue with neighbors red Honda blocking his driveway on Wareham Rd
2. White panel truck has been parking on Blossom Lane
3. A boat is being stored in driveway on Duxbury Road

Office Mudd will visit with each of the above violators to address the situations.

Finance Report: The first reading of Ordinance # 1 Series 2020 Ad Valorem tax assessment and Ordinance #2 Series 2020 Annual budget for fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 took place. The monthly bill report was presented to the council for review. Council member Scinta made a motion to approve the bills and council member O'Bryan seconded it. It passed 5/0 in favor.

The next meeting will be June 23, 2020 at 7:00pm.
