

Minutes February 23, 2021

The City of Langdon place held its regular monthly meeting at the John Knox Presbyterian Church.

Mayor Mike Frank called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Present at the meeting: Mayor Mike Frank, Commissioners Kenny Bauer, Charlie O'Bryan, Scott Scinta, Aaron Hardy, Attorney Stan Chauvin III and City Clerk/Treasurer Theresa O'Bryan.

Mayor Mike Frank began the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from the January meeting were read. Council member Kenny Bauer made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Council member Scott Scinta seconded the motion. It passed in favor of accepting the minutes 5/0.

Mayor Frank informed the council that Waste Management still needs to pick up 20 cans on Goose Creek Road. If they haven't been picked up in the next 3-5 days Ecotech Sanitation Company volunteered to pick them up and deliver them to WM.

Mayor Frank will be soliciting quotes for the upcoming mulching and fertilizing of the city trees.

Council Member Aaron Hardy told the council that the concerns for the decisions made in the last ice storm were based on being fiscally responsible as well as considering safety and security of the city. Due to the low temperatures on the days of the ice storm, the salt wasn't as effective. The decisions made were in the best interest at the time.

Council Member Kenny Bauer informed the council that officer David Hamlin will be available on Thursday of this week to obtain information for our webpage. Kenny also wanted the council to be aware that there are some suspicious incidents on the Next Door App that are soliciting money for families in need. Kenny cautioned everyone to carefully check them out before offering money in case of scams.

Attorney Chauvin filled the council in on the residents new court date of June 17th for the parking violations.

Finance Report: The monthly bill report was presented to the council for review. Council member Kenny Bauer made a motion to approve the bills and council member Scott Scinta seconded it. It passed 5/0 in favor.

The annual audit was presented to the council for review. Council Member Charlie O'Bryan made a motion to accept the audit as prepared and Council Member Aaron Hardy seconded it. It passed in favor of acceptance 5/0.

City Clerk O'Bryan will submit information on the Waste Management outstanding bill that is being disputed to Attorney Chauvin so he can draft a letter to the company.

The next meeting will be March 23, 2021 at 7:00pm.
