

Minutes December 28, 2021

The City of Langdon place held its regular monthly meeting at the John Knox Presbyterian Church.

Mayor Mike Frank called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Mike Frank began the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from the November meeting were read. Council member Nathan Bellows made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Council member Kenny Bauer seconded the motion. It passed in favor of accepting the minutes 4/0.

Ms. Demaree asked the council when the webpage information will be updated as well as when the next newsletter will be published and distributed?

Mr. Moose provided information about park benches made out of recycled plastic to the council.

Mayor Frank would like to consider adopting a no parking ordinance on Westbound Blossom between Wareham and Langdon Drive. Discussion of this ordinance took place. No resolution was obtained after discussion.

Mayor Frank had suggested the City donate to the relief fund from the tornado damage in the Western part of the state. The council decided it would be best to make individual contributions to the areas they choose. It was brought up to display on the website and newsletter information to help assist in where to mail your donation.

Attorney Chauvin will publish the "No parking" ordinance in the courier journal newspaper.

Council member Kenny Bauer informed the city that Duggins will be installing "no parking signs" with the ordinance attachment next week.

Council member Nathan Bellows was pleased with the second round of leaf pickup in December. A number of residents participated and Brownsboro Lawn Care did a good job on the pickup.

Finance Report: The monthly bill report was presented to the Council for review. Council member Kenny Bauer made a motion to approve the bills and council member Scott Scinta seconded it. It passed in favor 4/0.
