

Minutes November 22, 2022

The City of Langdon Place held its regular monthly meeting at the John Knox Presbyterian Church. Mayor Mike Frank called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Mayor Mike Frank began the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from the October meeting were read. Council Member Kenny Bauer made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Council Member Scott Scinta seconded the motion. It passed in favor of accepting the minutes 5/0.

Resident David Cheshire explained the water run off pooling problem in his back yard. Mayor Mike suggested to have David Tapp to clean the ditch area around 8903 Acushnet and to have Council member Kenny Bauer contact MSD to come and assess the area.

Council Member Kenny Bauer made a motion to provide ARPA funds to the Jefferson County Suburban Fire Services in the amount of \$10,000 for the Pandemic support bonus fund. Council Member Charlie O'Bryan seconded the motion. It passed 5/0 in favor of acceptance.

Mayor Mike Frank has asked Duggins for a quote to replace 10 signs and "no solicitation" signs in the neighborhood.

Sav-A-Tree will be planting 13 trees in the neighborhood next month to replace the trees that were removed.

Ecotech will be providing a new contract and pricing at the next meeting.

It was suggested to publish the Flock brochure in the next newsletter.

Finance Report: The monthly bill report was presented to the Council for review. Council Member Scott Scinta made a motion to approve the bills and Council Member Charlie OBryan seconded it. It passed in favor of acceptance 5/0.

There was no further business and Mayor Mike Frank adjourned the meeting at 8:10pm.
