CITY OF LANGDON PLACE ORDINANCE NO. 5 SERIES 2019

AN ORDINANCE regulating solicitation and peddling within the city limits of Langdon Place.

WHEREAS, the City, by and through its elected Officers, are desirous of passing this Ordinance for the safety and general well-being of its residents.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Commission of Langdon Place, Kentucky;

Section 1. Except as provided for in Section 2 below, it shall be unlawful for any person to solicit or peddle by going in and/or upon property within the city or ringing the doorbell or knocking on the door of a private residence, including apartments, for the purpose of soliciting or peddling for the sale of any goods, wares, merchandise, or any other services of any kind, unless, upon the express request or invitation of the owner/occupant of such residence or apartment.

Section 2. The provisions of Section 1. shall not be applicable to:

- (a) Any person soliciting or peddling for, or selling tickets for, any religious, charitable, and/or educational organization, or;
- (b) Fraternal organizations having established local chapters.

Section 3. All persons exempted under Section 2 above shall be required to obtain a permit, at no cost, from the City Clerk of Langdon Place before proceeding within the city limits with the permitted activity. Any permit issued pursuant to this section shall be valid for ten (10) days subsequent to issuance, which periods shall include weekends and holidays; and be always carried on the person of the applicant while engaged in the permitted activity in the City of Langdon Place.

<u>PENALTY</u>: Any violation of this ordinance shall constitute a violation and result in the imposition of a fine of \$150.00 for the first offense and \$500.00 for all subsequent violations. Each day that a person violates this ordinance shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval, passage and publication as required by law.
