

Minutes November 28, 2023

The City of Langdon Place held its regular monthly meeting at the John Knox Presbyterian Church. Mayor Mike Frank called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Present at the meeting: Mayor Mike Frank, Council members Charlie O'Bryan, Yolanda Demaree, Scott Scinta, Steve Casebeer, Attorney Stan Chauvin III and City Clerk/Treasurer Theresa O'Bryan.

Mayor Mike Frank began the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from the October 24, 2023 meeting were read. Council member Yolanda Demaree made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Council member Scott Scinta seconded the motion. It passed in favor of accepting the minutes 5/0.

Mayor Mike is looking into alternative mulching companies for bids in the spring. He has been talking to a company named Two Brothers who would like to place mulch and collect leaves on two sample homes in the neighborhood to illustrate the quality of their work. It was decided to use Council member Charlie O'Bryan and Yolanda Demaree's house as sample homes.

Council member Scott Scinta requested each council member to submit three homes for the holiday decoration awards to him by December 14th.

Council member Charlie O'Bryan said that Flock Safety has completed preventive maintenance on the cameras before winter. He also said that he will review any sidewalks for tripping hazards again in the Spring.

Council member Yolanda Demaree reported that the 8th district crime was down, and there is a new online portal from the police districts. It is "Who in the Lou am I". This online portal features photos of suspects from current LMPD cases. You can click on any photo and submit an anonymous tip to LMPD if you are able to identify the suspect.

- Phase II adding street lights in low lit areas.

She suggested making residents aware of the lighting changes before installation begins.

The monthly bill report was presented to the Council for review. Council member Yolanda Demaree made a motion to approve the bills and Council member Charlie O'Bryan seconded it. It passed in favor of acceptance 5/0.
