Minutes November 26, 2024

The City of Langdon Place held its regular monthly meeting at the John Knox Presbyterian Church. Mayor Mike Frank called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Finance Report:

The monthly bill report was presented to the Council for review. Council member Scott Scinta made a motion to approve the bills and Council member Steve Casebeer seconded it. It passed in favor of acceptance 4/0.

Welenken CPA has began working on the audit for the Fiscal year ending June 30, 2024. The audit cost will remain the same as last year at \$10,000. This expense will be paid out of ARPA funds.
